A Grand Cru from a Centenary Parcel

This Cuvée comes exclusively from a centenary parcel of 0,63 hectare planted in 1904, manually harvested and aged in new french oak barrels for 14 months.

In order to protect the noble character of the wine, the Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon grappes are sorted at the parcel itself.

Each bearing a unique number engraved on this antique shaped bottle as a tribute to the past, only 2007 bottles have been produced.

The Saint-Émilion Grand Cru so produced is rich and complex. The wine is dense and offers a concentration of black fruit flavours working powerfuly, with volume and exceptional length on the palate, all characteristics of a great vintage.



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
